All EC Classes – Students will be working their way through three different modules. Each group will have the experience working with Watercolor Stories with Gina Deeming where students express various watercolor techniques through story. Also there is Mosaics with James Turner where students learn the history and techniques of mosaic art. And Painting with Jack Bangerter where students learn about color mixing and various painting techniques.

ALL MC Classes – Students will be working their way through four different 3-week modules. They will have the experience of a dual module of Woodworking with the Woodworking Bus and Jim Sevrine, as well as ANSER Garden art where students spend time working on various types of art using items from the garden and for the garden. They will be experiencing Crafts Around the World with various parent-led experiences including learning about Dia De Los Muertos, the art of Japanese Haiku and printmaking as well as Latin art. Students will also be working with Diana Cryer learning Native American Art techniques and learning about the culture of some Native American tribes. Students will also have an opportunity to learn drawing techniques from Starla Bender.

ALL UC Classes – Students in UC will have a unique group of opportunities. All sixth grade students will experience SOS (Sixth Grade Year of Service) service learning lessons and planning of their SOS Projects. All fifth grade students will be cooking with Abundant Bowl owners Kim Rene and Anne Woodhouse, learning about healthy eating choices and how important food is to our lives. Students from all of UC will also be working with Laura Spencer learning about the “Masters” in art like M.C. Escher and tessellations. Another group of students also experienced amazing sculpture with Dianne Soule creating things like clay masks and mosaic glass works. The final two groups are working with Carol Dunn learning about fibers, how important they are to our daily lives, how they are harvested, spun and create beautiful works of art.
