

**“Winter Grit” CBC Grade 2-6
Bogus Basin Ski/Snowboard Option
Registration due Wed. Dec. 18**

LET it SNOW, LET it SNOW, LET it SNOW!

Students at Anser have the opportunity to participate in a **fee-based skiing or snowboarding** option for the Winter Grit CBC Session 3. Ski/snowboard students are asked to commit early to provide an accurate count and planning time for the other CBC options (more info coming in January).

The ski/snowboard program is 4 weeks: Jan. 30 – Feb. 20. Families should note that Bogus-bound students will not be back at school for afternoon pick-up until approximately 5:00 pm on Thursdays during this session.

Fees for this option are detailed on the “Life Sports” registration page. The program costs cover charter bus transportation between Anser and Bogus Basin, lessons from Bogus Basin instructors, lift tickets, and optional equipment rental. Students can select between downhill (alpine) skiing and snowboarding.

Chaperones are needed - no skiing ability required. Free lift tickets, free rental equipment, and approximately 90 minutes of blissful skiing or lodge solitude are available for adults who can drive or ride the bus and help the students before and after class (12 to 5 pm). Sign up on the last page for chaperone dates, or use link to Sign Up Genius <https://tinyurl.com/WinterGrit2020>. Free passes will be first come, first served as we only have a limited number.

*To arrange for your student to ride with a parent of your choice (**not on the bus**) and/or stay after at Bogus, the attached form must be received **the day before**. Last minute changes by phone will **NOT** be permitted.

Registration forms are due Wednesday, December 18th with deposit checks attached. Please use dark ink and fill out clearly and completely. Registration fees for siblings can be combined in one check, but please fill out a separate form for each student. Payment in installments is available, but a **NON-REFUNDABLE \$50 down payment is required with each registration form**. Fee must be paid in full by January 15, 2020; students who have not paid in full by this date will be moved to another module.

Life Sports 1 – Never Ever

For those who have never alpine skied, or snowboarded before, Lessons for first timers will begin with equipment familiarization and progress toward the use of the easiest beginner terrain and beginner lifts.

Life Sports 2 –Beginner & Intermediate Zone

For those who alpine ski or snowboard conservatively at slower speeds, on green and easy blue slopes, Instructors will help the students concentrate on developing speed control and explore tactics for skiing and riding on steeper slopes. Nordic skiers at this level ski comfortably on flats, but not on hills.

Life Sports 3 – Intermediate & Advanced Zone

At a minimum, participants must be able to ski or snowboard comfortably on blue terrain at moderate speeds and can turn both directions. Nordic students must be moderate skiers, able to maneuver up and down hills while staying in control. Intermediate and advanced classes will cover various topics depending on ability level. Topics may include breakthrough to parallel, terrain park sessions, advanced carving, and introduction to racing.

I agree to verify that the visual indicator settings to be recorded on this form for downhill ski equipment agree with the number appearing in the visual indicator windows of the equipment to be listed on this form.

Equipment Lease and Liability Release Agreement

I understand that the ski/boot/binding system cannot guarantee the user's safety. In downhill skiing, the binding system will not release at all times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release. In snowboarding, cross-country skiing, and Snowblade use, the binding system will NOT ordinarily release during use; these bindings are not designed to release as a result of forces generated during ordinary operation.

I understand and agree, if a helmet is rented, that a helmet IS IN NO WAY A GUARANTEE OF SAFETY and that no helmet can protect the wearer against all foreseeable impacts to the head or body, and that the sports of skiing, snowboarding, Snowblade, and other recreational activities can expose the user to forces that exceed the limits of protection provided by the helmet. I also understand that the helmet cannot guard against injury to the neck, spine or any other part of my body, and that these limitations are INHERENT RISKS of any activity in which a helmet may be used.

I understand that the sports of skiing, snowboarding, Snowblade, and other recreational activities involve inherent and other risks of INJURY and DEATH. I voluntarily agree to expressly assume all risks of injury or death that may result from skiing, snowboarding, and Snowblade use, or which relate in any way to the use of this equipment.

I AGREE TO RELEASE the ski/snowboard shop, its employees, owners, affiliates, agents, officers, directors and the manufacturers and distributors of this equipment (collectively " PROVIDERS "), from all liability for injury, death, property loss and damage which results from the equipment user's participation in the sport of skiing/snowboarding/Snowblade use, or is in any way related to the use of this equipment, including all liability which results from the NEGLIGENCE of PROVIDERS, or any other person or cause.

I further agree to defend and indemnify PROVIDERS for any loss or damage, including any that results from claims or lawsuits for personal injury, death, and property loss and damage related in any way to the use of this equipment.

This agreement is governed by the applicable law of this state or province. If any provision of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other provisions shall be given full force and effect.

THIS DOCUMENT IS A LEGALLY BINDING CONTRACT which supersedes any other agreements or representations by or between the parties. It shall be interpreted to provide as broad and inclusive a release of liability as is legally possible, but is not intended to assert any claims or defenses which are prohibited by law.
